1. Attempt by Critical Mass, a group of cyclists, to prevent the Queen from reaching the Olympic Stadium in time for the Opening Ceremony. ☐
2. Attempted cyberattack on the National Grid by the Chinese during the Opening Ceremony. ☐
3. An illegal drug added to Usain Bolt's and Mo Farah's urine samples in an attempt to have them disqualified. ☐
4. Suspected IRA van with a bomb on board reported heading towards London on the day of the Opening Ceremony. ☐
5. Attempt by the Russians to interfere with the stadium generator and broadcasting facilities during the Opening Ceremony. ☐
6. Attempt by the Chinese to release a nerve gas during the Closing Ceremony. ☐

7. A female Russian athlete was abducted and flown back to Moscow during the Games. ☐
8. A London taxi driver abandoned his taxi on Tower Bridge and jumped into the Thames an hour before the Opening Ceremony and was rescued by the river police. ☐
9. South Korean national flag displayed on a screen before the start of a football match between North Korea and Colombia. ☐
10. A report by the Russian volleyball team of a shot fired on their coach while driving to Earl's Court. ☐
11. Fathers 4 Justice light aircraft headed towards the stadium during the Closing Ceremony and intercepted by a fighter jet. ☐
12. An additional 3,500 army personnel had to be drafted in just days before the Games began due to a lack of trained security staff. ☐
13. A French athlete committed suicide after his Russian fiancée was abducted and flown to Moscow. ☐
14. Brad Pitt and Angelina Jolie applied to run in the torch relay, but were turned down. ☐
15. Taxi drivers staged a protest because they were not permitted to pick up passengers within three miles of the Olympic Park. ☐
16. Terrorist attacks on London public transport the day after the successful vote took place in Singapore. ☐
17. Man arrested for attempting to put out the torch relay flame while on its way to the Olympic Park. ☐
18. Man murdered and buried in the long jump pit after the Games had ended. ☐
19. West Ham football club obtained a lease on the Olympic Stadium for £2.5m per annum. ☐
